

Furniture reuse referrals to customers

What we are doing

In order to reduce waste from voids, we'll be working with local reuse companies to collect furniture and goods left behind from our premises.

Before the property becomes void, and therefore Grand Union's "problem", we'd like to help our customers to be able to dispose of waste that they can't take with them by referring them to reuse organisations.

Changing the way we work is an essential part of making our business more sustainable.

Adopting this reuse scheme will help to:

- enhance our customers experience and avoid costs
- saving the business money i.e reducing our voids waste bill
- supporting our (potential) upcoming reuse scheme for customers
- reducing items sent to landfill.

Safety

All upholstered/leather items and mattresses must have a fire label to be collected for reuse to conform with the Furniture and Furnishings (Fire Safety) Regulations and BS7177, the safety standard for resistance to ignition of mattresses, divans and bed bases.

Upholstered items in all these categories must be in good condition and the covering intact with no rips or tears which may compromise the ignition tests.

Below are examples of fire labels that you can expect to find.

This article contains CM Foam which passes the specified test. All upholstery is cigarette resistant.

> All cover fabric is cotton and is match resistant

To comply with The Furniture and Furnishings (Fire) (Safety) Regulations: This article does not include a Schedule 3 interliner.

All foams, fillings and composites have been tested to ensure compliance with the relevant ignitability test. All covers and fillings have been tested to ensure that they are cigarette resistant. All covers have been tested to ensure that they are match resistant. This article contains CM Foam which passes the specified test. All upholstery is cigarette resistant.
